## THE GERALD PERMAN FUND FOR EMERGING ARTISTS

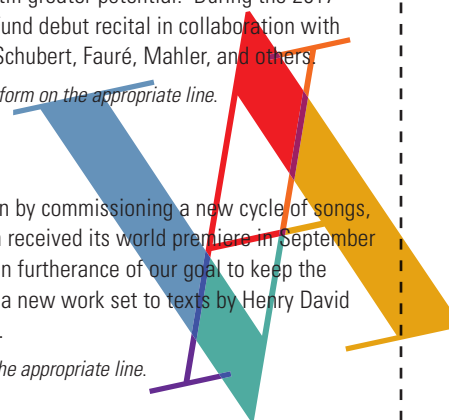
On the occasion of the 90th birthday in 2013 of Gerald Perman, our esteemed founder (1923-2015), Vocal Arts DC established the Gerald Perman Fund for Emerging Artists. The Gerald Perman Fund pays tribute to his longstanding dedication to the promotion and presentation of performances by some of the world's finest vocalists during the earliest stages of their illustrious careers. Each season, resources from the Gerald Perman Fund help defray the costs of a Vocal Arts DC debut recital by an emerging young talent of outstanding accomplishment and still greater potential. During the 2017-2018 season, the exciting young baritone Theo Hoffman, a 2016 Juilliard alumnus, will present our Perman Fund debut recital in collaboration with pianist Bradley Moore, offering a program he has titled, *Abendphantasie*, musical evocations of evening by Schubert, Fauré, Mahler, and others.

## VOCAL ARTS DC NEW WORKS FUND

On the occasion of our 25th Anniversary in 2015, the Board of Directors of Vocal Arts DC launched our season by commissioning a new cycle of songs, *Iconic Legacies: First Ladies* at the Smithsonian, from composer Jake Heggie and lyricist Gene Scheer, which received its world premiere in September of that year sung by mezzo-soprano Susan Graham. The New Works Fund will support similar commissions in furtherance of our goal to keep the art song repertoire fresh and vital. In April of 2018, baritone Brian Mulligan will offer the world premiere of a new work set to texts by Henry David Thoreau by Gregory Spears, one of the most excitingly original new "voices" among artists of his generation.
